



Our second production this season is a remount of last year's popular **THE LARAMIE PROJECT** by Moises Kaufmann and The Tectonic Theatre Project about the Wyoming town's response to the murder of Matthew Shepard. "We are remounting the show this year for two reasons. The first is that we wanted to give more people an opportunity to experience this brilliant piece of theatre which so closely relates to our mission statement. The second is because we are hoping to be granted the rights to premier the brand new epilogue to the piece, entitled **TEN YEARS LATER**. This new epilogue finds the company returning to Laramie at the ten year anniversary, conducting more interviews to see how things have or haven't changed," mentions Producing Artistic Director Posey.

The ensemble cast of nine features two performers who have done the show four times, Becki Jordan and Garry Lee Posey. Returning from last year's cast is Randal Fosse, Jonathan Nichols, John Thomas Cecil and Joey Tipton. Rounding out the cast are ETC newcomers E'tienne Easley, Stephanie Smith and Amy Sue Austin. Casey Keelen stage manages and co-directs. There will be four performances of **THE LARAMIE PROJECT** on October 16th at 7:30, 17th at 3:00 and 18th at 3:00 and 7:30. Tickets will be \$10.00 for Adults and \$8.00 for students.

In addition, ETC is in rehearsals for a touring production of last season's hit **A WOMAN CALLED TRUTH**. Several elementary schools have already been booked, dates are still available. **A WOMAN CALLED TRUTH** along with **THIS IS NOT A PIPE DREAM** (itself already with a few bookings) are a part of ETC's newly formed Education and Outreach programming.
